- Discuss final details for the IP competency framework,
- Writing the business case for the SR-IPLW,
- Analysing the interviews of the patient journeys,
- Writing an article about interprofessional identity of students after internship at the SR-IPLW,
- Analysing data of the focus group meetings of health care professionals working at the SR-IPLW.

Working at all these various activities in this phase of the project, we notice that all parts wonderfully assemble. For example, the competencies, ICF and coaching in relation to the SR-IPLW. And that is our final goal: improve the quality of rehabilitation medicine by client-centred practice!
