#### *Interprofessional bachelor thesis: challenge accepted!*

The aim of this educational innovation is that future health care professionals conclude their bachelor programmes at the highest level of interprofessional competencies and are 'collaboration ready' for daily practice.

#### *Use of key competences in postgraduate courses.*

40 health care professionals, enrolled in a postgraduate course for interprofessional rehabilitation, have done a self-assessment on the EIPEN key competences. Results will be reported in comparison with bachelor/master programmes, and related to professional experience of participants.

### Hester Smeets

#### *Design guidelines for the assessment of students' IP competencies.*

A qualitative consensus study was conducted using the Nominal Group Technique in several sessions, to define and prioritize guidelines. Although each expert group had unique perspectives consensus was reached in three main areas and 26 design guidelines.

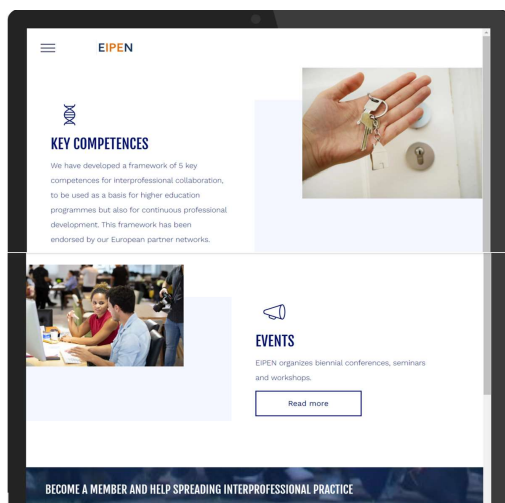

## Did you visit the new EIPEN website ?

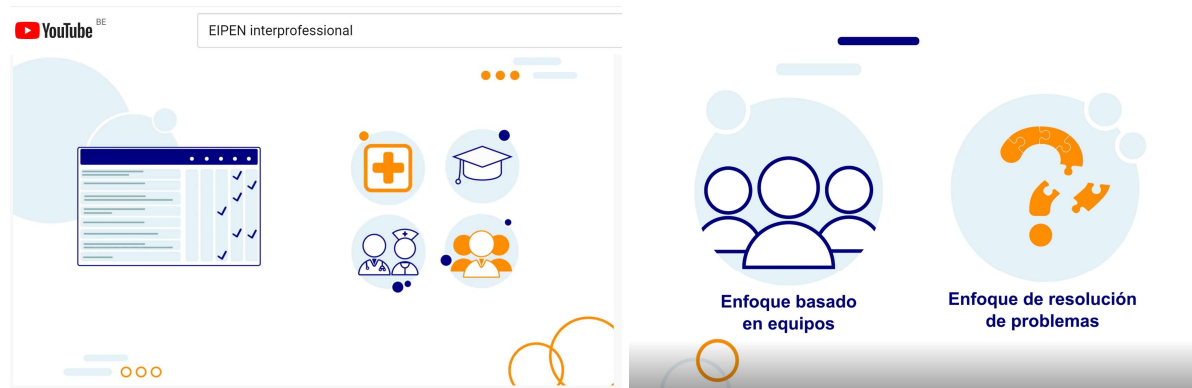

## Proudly presenting: Video clips on the EIPEN key competences model



The EIPEN key competences model is available in a nice brochure of 10 pages, explaining the background, the characteristics, and the structure of the competence areas and behavioural indicators. The indicators have been operationalized in handy assessment sheets.

But we also have produced a 3-minute videoclip or explanation. The English version was launched in October and has been viewed by more than 400 persons in 2 months time. To further reach across borders we have produced translated versions in French, German, Spanish, and Dutch. All clips are available in the video channel on Youtube and can be accessed through our website.

As you already know, EIPEN has opted for a concise model of key competences for interprofessional collaboration: clear, manageable, and easy to use. The thoroughly revised version of 2021 has been validated by experts of all institutional EIPEN members. It will be used in a follow-up phase with European associations of professional bodies, and is open for testing by higher education institutions and training centres. Our associate partners ENPHE and COEHRE will be involved in the further deployment and dissemination. Translated versions are now being made in Dutch, French, Spanish, and German. The model will also be used in a transnational project in Africa.
